To recognise that in Edinburgh it is schools, working with pupils and parents, who decide on subject choice and how many National 4s and 5s pupils sit."
- 2) To delete the points 1 to 5 submitted for noting.
- This should cover the whole school experience, including subject choice, methods for gaining qualifications, including National Qualifications, Skills for Work, Vocational Qualifications, and opportunities for wider achievement. The report should detail any changes suggested by the Scottish Government after their review of the implementation of the Curriculum for Excellence and the potential impact on Edinburgh Council Schools. This will include information in relation to points 1 to 5 as identified in the final part of the motion.
